AVAILABILITY OF CHEMICAL WARFARE PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT FOR FAMILIARIZATION PURPOSES

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Advisory Bulletin is to inform State and local civil defense directors of the availability and requirements for obtaining, on grant from OCDM, chemical warfare protective equipment sets for demonstration and familiarization purposes.

II. DESCRIPTION

Each of the sets, designated "CD V-855, Protective Equipment Set, Chemical Warfare Defense," contains 8 protective masks (4 organizational and 4 military lightweight), 1 chemical agent detector kit, and 4 OCDM publications.

III. EXPLANATION

A. Under the provision of Section 3, Public Law 85-606, which in part amended Section 201 (h) of the Federal Civil Defense Act of 1950 (64 Stat. 1245; 50 U.S.C. App. 2251), the Director of the Office of Civil and Defense Mobilization is authorized to procure and maintain protective masks and gas detection kits, and to distribute them by loan or grant to the States for civil defense purposes until June 30, 1964.

- B. OCDM has available a limited supply of organizational and military lightweight protective masks and chemical agent detector kits. Therefore, the CD V-855 protective equipment sets have been assembled and will be allocated to the States, upon request, according to the following formula: 2 times the population percentage plus the area percentage divided by 3. (See allocation totals in Attachment "A".)
 - 1. The CD V-855 Protective Equipment Set, Chemical Warfare Defense, should be ordered under the provisions of this Advisory Bulletin.
 - 2. Each set contains the following items, which should not be ordered separately:

IV. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To take part in this program, each State agrees to:

- A. Inform government and auxiliary personnel with emergency civil defense assignments of the purpose, use, and care of the protective mask and chemical agent detector kit, using as a guide the familiarization booklet contained in the kit. The booklet is based on the three technical bulletins which are also included in the kit.
- B. Maintain each item of equipment as provided in the familiarization booklet, so long as such maintenance will result in the particular item of equipment being operable.

V. PROCEDURES

- A. All negotiations and arrangements for transfer and grant of the CD V-855 chemical warfare protective equipment sets will be made by the State civil defense organization with the OCDM Regional Office concerned.
- B. A form letter of request (FL OCDM-42) (Attachment "B") and an application/agreement form (OCDM-148) (Attachment "C") are available to the States from OCDM Regional Offices. (The application/agreement form dated February 1960 supersedes the form dated November 1959.)
- C. The following step-by-step procedure will be followed in granting the CD V-855 sets to the States:
 - 1. The State shall submit the letter of request (Form FL OCDM-42) and the intended briefing schedule in duplicate, together with 4 copies of an executed application/agreement (Form OCDM-148), to the OCDM Regional Director concerned.
 - 2. The Regional Office will review the request and briefing schedule and will retain copies of each for reference. The original request and briefing schedule with the 4 copies of the application/agreement, Form OCDM-148, executed by the State and signed by the Regional Director, indicating review and recommendation for approval, will be forwarded to Training and Education, OCDM Operational Headquarters, Battle Creek, Mich.

- 3. Training and Education, OCDM Operational Headquarters, Battle Creek, Mich., will evaluate the request for grant and allocation of equipment on the basis of the documentation submitted and the availability of equipment.
- 4. After approval by Training and Education, the letter of request and briefing schedule with the 4 copies of the OCDM application/agreement will be forwarded to Administrative Operations Office, Administration. The Administrative Operations Office will execute the application/agreement for the Federal Government and arrange for shipment of the protective equipment sets. The letter of request and briefing schedule with 2 copies of the executed application/agreement will be retained by Administrative Operations Office, OCDM Operational Headquarters, Battle Creek, Mich. The remaining 2 copies will be returned to the OCDM Regional Office concerned. The Regional Office will keep 1 copy, and will send 1 copy to the State concerned.
- 5. OCDM will pay shipping cost of the equipment granted to the State between the OCDM shipping point and the State's receiving station.
- 6. Equipment will be shipped in bulk lots consigned to a single receiving point as designated in the request. Each request may indicate a receiving point different from that of a previous request, if desired. Redistribution and transshipment within the State for all protective equipment sets will be at State expense.
- 7. Each protective equipment set will be shipped in a corrugated fiberboard box 19-1/4" by 17-1/4" by 16-1/2" and each set will weigh approximately 35 pounds.
- 8. Each State civil defense director or custodian will acknowledge receipt of each shipment and forward signed

copies of shipping documents to the Director, Property Division, OCDM Operational Headquarters, Battle Creek, Mich.

- 4. Title to the equipment granted will pass to the State upon delivery to the State or State-designated custodian(s).
